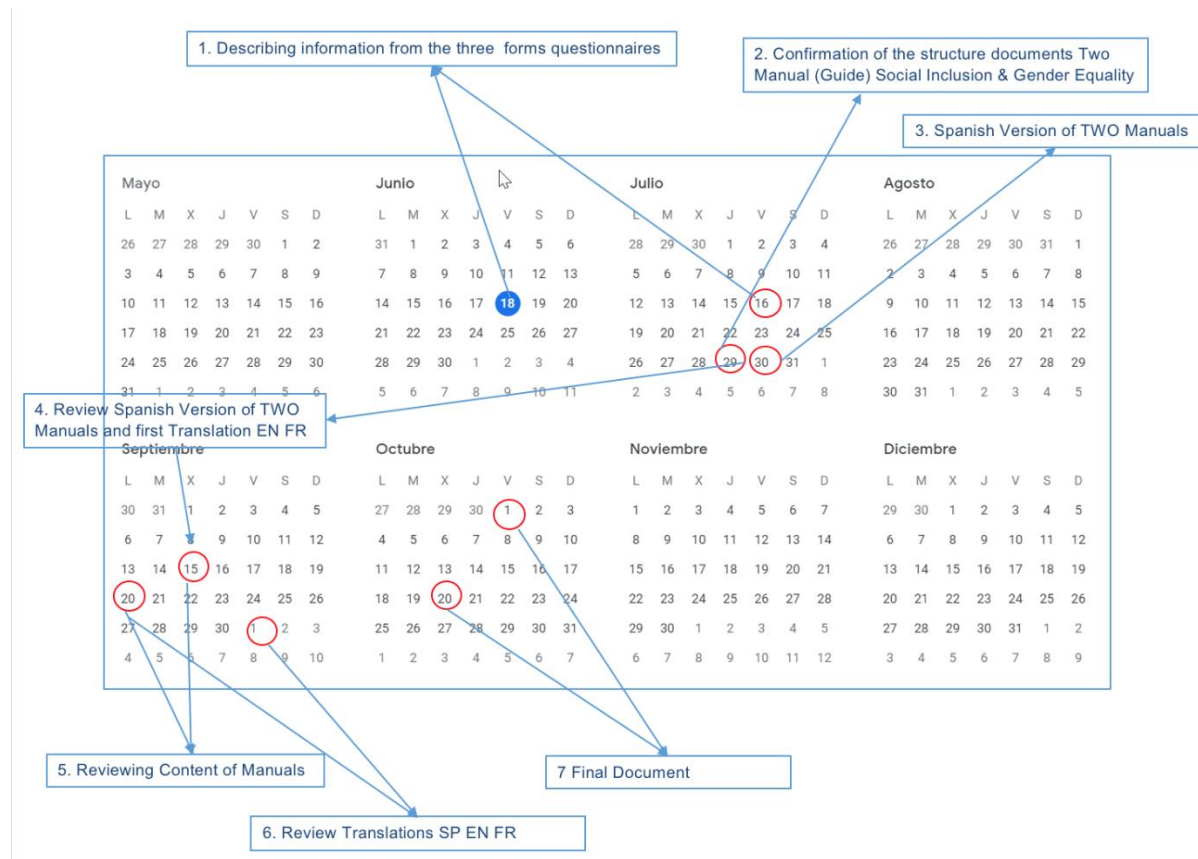
1. Further steps on IO1 development.

The project partners agreed to compile the information in excel into two Word documents, structuring the content by the topics (materials, good practices, courses):

- one on social inclusion,
- another one on gender equality.

For the moment the information should be presented in the same language as it was recollected and later on it will be translated into EN, ES and FR in accordance with the project proposal.

Activity 2.3. Design of the Methodology of the TSG Pilot Inclusive Actions (IRSiE, INEFC)

Activity 2.4. Identification of local stakeholders (Territorial Implementation Groups) and interventional scenarios (UC, INEFC)

INEFC presented two versions of the Newsletter Template. The partners chose one by voting. The Newsletter will be published in early July.

At the end of the meeting the project partners also briefly discussed some ideas on App development. UL commented that they created the questionnaire for App to monitor how the project activities changed existing attitudes towards social inclusion. Next January UL will send the questionnaire to all partners in order to proceed with Evaluation Methodology. For this It's necessary to know which interventional scenarios we will use within each Pilot territory. The partners should define them in September-October.
